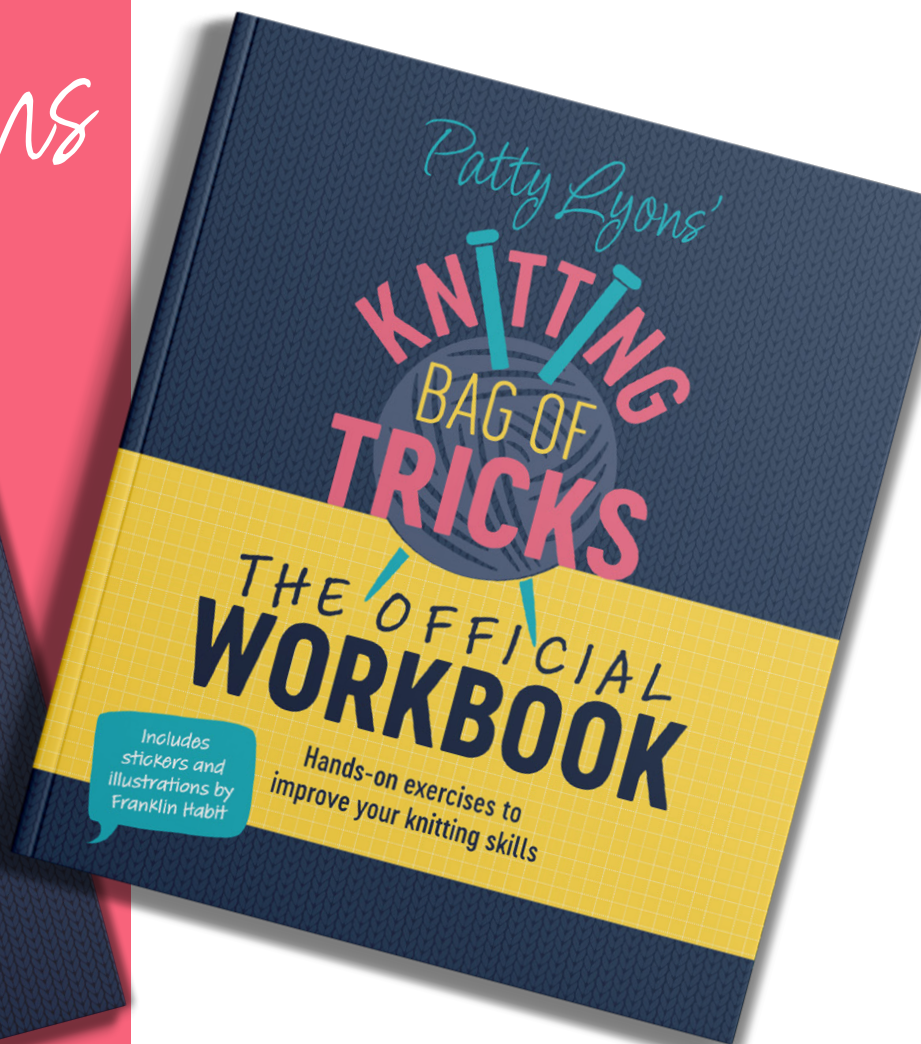

INTRODUCTION

How to Use Your Workbook

This workbook is meant to be worked hand in hand with Patty Lyons' *Knitting Bag of Tricks*. Keep the book handy and refer to it as you work through the lessons. If it's been a while since you read *Bag of Tricks*, you might want to review each chapter before diving into the correlating workbook lesson.

The workbook is divided into three sections:

- 1 EXERCISES
- 2 STICKERS
- 3 MY WORK

Each lesson will correspond to a chapter of the book.

- You'll work a series of swatches that will allow you to practice every trick in the book.
- Since you'll be working on some swatches in more than one lesson, it's helpful to tag each swatch with its number. You can place swatches on a stitch holder or waste yarn so you don't run out of needles. Since some of the swatches will be seamed, it'll be helpful to use the same yarn for Swatches #6 through #13.
- Look for the "See also" tags that refer to a corresponding section of the book. This way you can remind yourself of instructions as you work.
- After each exercise, you'll find a "Swatchservations" section for notes and a question or two as a prompt. You can answer the questions or write about anything that is personal to your knitting. Don't rush this; it's helpful to refer to these notes as you grow.
